



The free Infosound information service for vision-impaired people

Infosound, a registered charity and professional audio producer, provides a free and impartial information service specifically for blind and partially-sighted people in Great Britain.

They cover a very broad range of subjects, such as daily-living products, leisure and holidays, hobbies and sport, mobility and travel, housing, employment and training, money and consumer issues, support services, news stories and events.

Infosound presents its news and information as a round-the-clock rolling “broadcast” and also as an “on-demand” service, where listeners can choose which audio features they want to hear whenever it suits them.

Infosound can be heard on any landline or mobile phone, on the Infosound web site, on British Wireless for the Blind Fund’s Sonata audio players and Bumblebee tablet, as a podcast and via Twitter.

And vision-impaired people are encouraged to phone-in to contribute their own hints, tips, items of news and information and comments for other blind and partially-sighted people to hear.
