



Promoting Yourself on Infosound

Infosound is a registered charity and professional producer of impartial news and information, in audio, specifically for blind and partially-sighted people in Great Britain.

We produce and broadcast information on a very broad range of subjects, such as daily-living products, leisure and holidays, social opportunities, hobbies and sport, mobility and travel, housing, employment and training, money and consumer issues, support services, news stories and events. We also broadcast vision-impaired people's hints, tips, items of information and comments.

Infosound is broadcast as a round-the-clock, rolling stream of information and, separately, the most recent audio items can also be browsed individually on-demand. Both services can be accessed using a standard landline phone, a computer, laptop, tablet or smart mobile phone and they can also be heard on some specialist audio players.

Importantly, we not only produce information that is relevant to the whole of the Great Britain, but we also feature regional and local services, events and information.

So, if you run a regular service that benefits vision-impaired people (however long it has been running) or you are putting on an event for the benefit of those who live with sight loss, please do tell us about it so we can pass on the information to the several thousand listeners who hear us every week. Whatever it is, we would like to hear about it.

Please email us the details, specifically giving us information on what it's about, who can benefit from the service or event, any costs involved, the dates and times and, importantly, a phone number and email address where listeners can get further details. We will then turn what you send us into a script, which we will read and broadcast on Infosound.

We would appreciate as much notice as possible – we suggest at least a month – so the information can become well-circulated and heard by as many people as possible.
