Infosound – professional producers of news and information, in audio, specifically for blind and partially-sighted people – provides a free news and information service for anyone in Great Britain who lives with sight loss.

Infosound covers a very broad range of subjects, such as daily-living products, leisure and holidays, hobbies and sport, mobility and travel, housing, employment and training, money and consumer issues, support services, news stories and events. And vision-impaired listeners can phone-in to contribute as well.

The Great Britain-wide Infosound service can be heard on a free monthly audio CD; but it is also kept frequently-updated online, on the British Wireless for the Blind Sonata Internet audio players and it can be automatically ‘delivered’ to computers, tablets and smart mobile phones by the Infosound podcast.
